'Natural' = "as a result of being ... a healthy church"

Natural Church Development as Jesus's Idea

^{"1}I AM the True Vine, and My Father is the Vinedresser. ²Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away, and every branch that does bear fruit He prunes, that it may bear more fruit ...

Natural Church Development as Jesus's Idea

"⁴Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in The Vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me. ⁵I AM the Vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in Me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from Me you can do nothing." – Jesus to His disciples (John 15:1-2, 4-5, ESV)

NCD Church Health Survey Respondent Criteria

- Member of a group (in growing fellowship)

- Committed to the life and health of Bethesda (invested in <u>Bethesda's future</u>)
- 18+ years old (able to understand and respond)
